### Parking

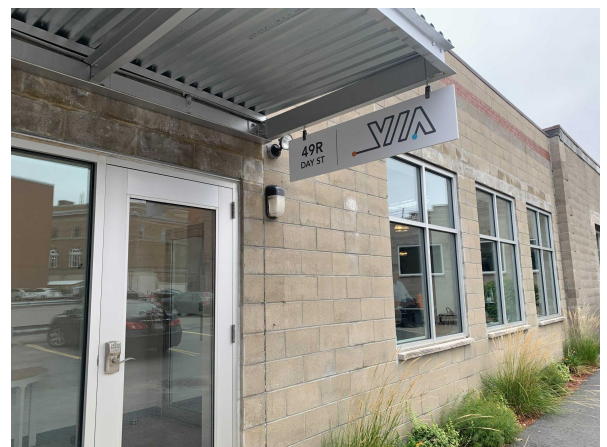
- If you require parking, please let us know and we will reserve a spot in our parking lot for you.

### Driving

- If you are driving to the office (whether using your vehicle or a car-share service like Uber or Lyft), enter 49R Day Street, Somerville, MA. We are located on a one-way street. Our office entrance is on the left after the American Flatbread restaurant.

### Public Transit

- Davis Station is the closest subway station (Red Line) and bus stop (bus 87, 88, 89, 90, 94, 96).
- VIA is a 3-minute walk from Davis Station: exit the station onto Holland St. (which turns into Elm St., make a right down Elm St., then right onto Dover St. Walk across the parking lot straight ahead, where you will see a large garage door on the right, that is our office (pictured above).

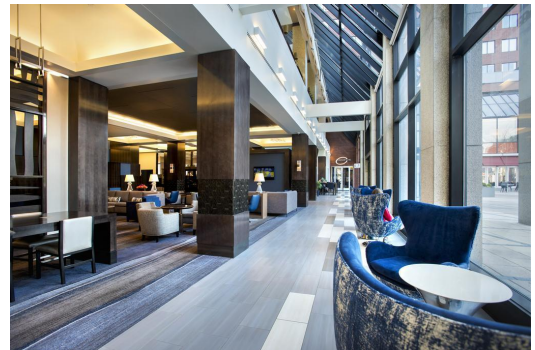

### Outdoor Activities

#### Boston Duck Tours

Tour historic Boston in a WWII style amphibious landing vehicle, where your ConDUCKtor will give you fun and interesting facts about the city and plunge into the Charles River for views of Boston's skyline. \$41.99 for Adults (departs from Museum of Science, Prudential Center, and New England Aquarium)

#### Faneuil Hall & Quincy Market

Visit the historical Faneuil Hall and Quincy Market to experience a world of shopping, dining, streets entertainment, and theater and live bands.

#### Freedom Trail

The Freedom Trail is a 2.5-mile route that takes you to 16 historical sites throughout the city of Boston. Along the way you will find museums, meetinghouses, churches, and old burial grounds. Tours are available, or you could go about the trail yourself, just grab a map!

#### Fenway Park

April through October: catch a Red Sox game at baseball's most beloved ballpark, Fenway Park.

### Indoor Activities

#### Museum of Science, Boston

#### North End
